WIRELINES / SLICKLINES

In the oil industry, wireline service companies use wirelines (also called slicklines) to perform well maintenance services. These include: well depth measurements, retrieving safety valves or plugs, opening and closing down hole circulating devices, and high speed data retrieval and transmission wire. Tree Island Steel Industrial Alloys produces solid wirelines in carbon grades IPS and EIP, as well as corrosion-resistant grades. Break strength and recommended safe working loads for each grade are available upon request. Packed as continuous lengths of wires on heavy-duty metal or wooden reels, with no welds. Lengths typically range from 10,000 ft to 40,000 ft.
